

From checking your balance to viewing your transaction history, customers may send text-based commands<sup>1</sup> to MainSource Bank using their mobile device. By texting “454545”, customers can access their banking information anytime, anywhere.

Text commands, their detailed descriptions, and sample responses are provided below.
